She received her bachelors of science in 2004. Dr. Kubicek attended the Atlantic Veterinary College at the University of Prince Edward Island, graduating with a doctors of veterinary medicine in 2008.

She completed a 12 month rotating internship in small animal medicine and surgery at the University of Wisconsin followed by a specialty internship in medical oncology clinical trials at the University of Wisconsin. In 2012 she completed her residency in radiation oncology at the University of Wisconsin. Dr. Kubicek became a Diplomate of the American College of Veterinary Radiology in 2013.

Dr. Kubicek was instrumental in building the radiation oncology programs at both the University of Florida and Angell Animal Medical Center in Boston, MA. She is a recognized leader in the field of veterinary radiation oncology and has extensive training in advanced radiation techniques such as stereotactic radiation therapy (SRS/SRT/SBRT), intensity modulated radiation therapy (IMRT) and volumetric arc therapy (VMAT). Dr. Kubicek has been invited to speak at multiple national meetings and has authored and co-authored numerous peer reviewed publications. She is active in peer reviewing veterinary oncology articles in multiple journals.
